### Change of Days for Rubbish & Recycling

Residents on the Thursday refuse collection route and residents in the northern recycling collection area are advised of changes to the normal rubbish and recycling collection schedule due to Good Friday and ANZAC Day public holidays. Refuse: regular collection day of Thursday, 18 April – now Wednesday, 17 April. Regular recycling collection day: Friday, 19 April, now Thursday, 18 April. Regular refuse collection day: Thursday 25 April, now Wednesday, 24 April.
