Please do not add coals to waste

Adding coals from wood fires or barbecues into your waste can ignite a fire. Please do not put coals of any kind into the green waste at the Clare Waste Transfer Station.

Please segregate your waste

When bringing waste into the Clare Waste Transfer Station at Bennys Hill it should be segregated into categories – Segregating waste helps reduce costs to Council (ratepayers). Categories are as follows: scrap metal; electrical appliances; timber; mattresses; e-waste; green waste; empty fire extinguishers; clean drums; household/kitchen waste; car/truck batteries; plastic waste oil containers; small quantity clean concrete and tiles; glass; paper/cardboard; empty gas cylinders; household recyclables. What is not accepted – ammunition/explosives/flares; asbestos; chemicals; cooking oil; paint tins; hazardous waste; liquid waste; dead animals; soils/ commercial loads of construction and demolition material; tyres.

Council Elections

Council elections will be held in November 2022 and are held by postal vote. The voters' roll closes on July 29, 2022 and nominations open on 23 August 2022 – closing 6 September 2022. Voting material will be posted in October with close of voting 10 November. More information on our website:
