New Kerbside Collection Calendar

The FOGO (Food Organics and Garden Organics) bin collection will begin this month. All bins will be collected fortnightly (FOGO, general waste, recycling). Your general waste and recycling bin days will remain the same, but both will be collected fortnightly.

Fortnightly general rubbish collection (small 140L bin) will begin as follows:

WED 1 FEB: Clare South (south of Victoria Rd & Lennon St), Sevenhill, Mintaro, Auburn, Watervale, Penwortham

THURS: 2 FEB: Manoora, Marrabel, Rhynie, Riverton, Saddleworth, Stockport, Tarlee, Undalya, Waterloo.

Fortnightly FOGO (Food Organics & Garden Organics) 240L green bodied bin, will commence in the second week of February as follows:

MON 6 FEB: Clare North (north of and including Victoria Rd and Lennon St), Sevenhill, Mintaro, Leasingham, Penwortham.

TUES 7 FEB: Clare South, Auburn, Watervale.

WED 8 FEB: Saddleworth, Riverton.

THURS 9 FEB: Manoora, Waterloo, Marrabel, Undalya, Tarlee, Stockport, Rhynie, Armagh.

Fortnightly Recycling Collection – (240L black bodied bin) – your collection days will remain the same.
