Council will soon start the next part of the Clare Main Street Upgrade. New works will involve the renewal of footpaths, kerb and gutters on both sides of Ness Street, Clare. Works are to commence on 18 March and are expected to take 4-6 weeks, depending on the weather. Traffic control will be in place and YP Coaches will be relocated for the duration of the work – location of the bus stop is yet to be determined.
