All you need to know about the Mid North Community Passenger Network and essential travel options for the entire community is on their updated website, including an online booking service. The network is a not-for-profit community organisation providing a transport service to residents and communities within local government areas including the Clare & Gilbert Valleys. Community cars are available to transport disadvantaged residents to medical and health appointments locally or to metropolitan areas. Transport may also be arranged for shopping, banking, pharmacy, hairdressing appointments, visiting friends or social events. Please segregate your waste

When bringing waste into the Clare Waste Transfer Station at Bennys Hill it should be segregated into categories – Segregating waste helps reduce costs to Council (ratepayers). Categories are as follows: scrap metal; electrical appliances; timber; mattresses; e-waste; green waste; empty fire extinguishers; clean drums; household/kitchen waste; car/truck batteries; plastic waste oil containers; small quantity clean concrete and tiles; glass; paper/cardboard; empty gas cylinders; household recyclables. What is not accepted – ammunition/explosives/flares; asbestos; chemicals; cooking oil; paint tins; hazardous waste; liquid waste; dead animals; soils/ commercial loads of construction and demolition material; tyres.

Free e-waste service

Council residents can safely recycle their electronic waste without charge at the Bennys Hill, Clare Waste Transfer Station. Approved items can be dropped off during normal opening times. The following items can be recycled and used in manufacturing new products instead of going to landfill: computer equipment, printers, scanners, game consoles, video recorders, DVD players, whitegoods, household appliances, power tools, radios, stereo equipment, non-computer batteries, televisions.

Council Elections

Council elections will be held in November 2022 and are held by postal vote. The voters' roll closes on July 29, 2022 and nominations open on 23 August 2022 – closing 6 September 2022.
