Which Bin?

Recycle hard plastics - milk containers, juice, soft drink etc, into the BLACK BODIED RECYCLING BIN. Dispose of soft plastic bags - supermarket bags, green garbage bags - into the SMALL GENERAL WASTE BIN.

Please only put ORGANIC WASTE into your GREEN BODIED FOGO BIN.

For example, do not put prunings, lawn clippings, etc into plastic bags and then into the FOGO bin - these can be tipped straight into your bin.

Fortnightly Recycling Collection – (240L black bodied bin) – your collection days will remain the same.
