Footpath & Kerbing upgrade Torrens Rd, Riverton

Council has commenced upgrading footpath & kerbing along the eastern side of Torrens Road, Riverton, from Elizabeth Street to the Riverton Gallery building, which will be replaced with an aggregate footpath the same as that on the western side of Torrens Road, including new kerb and guttering. It is expected works will take 8-9 weeks to complete, weather permitting.

The works will be coordinated to cause minimal interference to the adjacent business along Torrens Road during operating hours. Parking will not be available where the works are taking place and traffic controls will be in place for the duration of the works.

Please segregate your waste

When bringing waste into the Clare Waste Transfer Station at Bennys Hill it should be segregated into categories – Segregating waste helps reduce costs to Council (ratepayers). Categories are as follows: scrap metal; electrical appliances; timber; mattresses; e-waste; green waste; empty fire extinguishers; clean drums; household/kitchen waste; car/truck batteries; plastic waste oil containers; small quantity clean concrete and tiles; glass; paper/cardboard; empty gas cylinders; household recyclables. What is not accepted – ammunition/explosives/flares; asbestos; chemicals; cooking oil; paint tins; hazardous waste; liquid waste; dead animals; soils/ commercial loads of construction and demolition material; tyres.

Council Elections

Council elections will be held in November 2022 and are held by postal vote. The voters' roll closes on July 29, 2022 and nominations open on 23 August 2022 – closing 6 September 2022.
