What to do if you received a new waste bin

New 240L Black Body bins are being delivered to all properties with a current waste and recycling pick up service. Please remove the small kitchen waste caddy and set aside for future use and then use these bins for your fortnightly recycling. Please store your former recycling bin until the new Green Waste Collection service commences early in 2023. Your regular weekly refuse collection will continue uninterrupted for the remainder of 2022. Keep a lookout for a new waste collection calendar in the new year.

Changes to waste collection

Watch for information through a wide range of channels – advertisements, articles, social media and newsletter about upcoming changes to your waste collection, which will include a new Food Organics and Green Organics collection, which will commence in 2023. More information will be provided.

Lost Dogs

Several dogs have been handed in to Council in recent weeks when they have been found wandering in the district. Pet owners are reminded it is now mandatory to have your dogs and cats microchipped. Microchipping assists Council in returning your pet to you, saving both owners and animals unnecessary distress.

The Riverton Waste Transfer Station, 15 Bruce Road, Riverton, is open fortnightly on Sundays from 10am – 2pm and is free for residents and ratepayers with a Council Waste Transfer Card (domestic volumes only).
