A smoking ceremony followed by a bush food inspired dinner will celebrate NAIDOC's 2023 Theme 'For Our Elders' in August.

Everyone is invited – the Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Community would love to share their culture with the whole community and looks forward to seeing you. The event at the Clare Town Hall on Saturday, 5 August, will feature fun and entertainment for everyone, including inspiring storytelling, Deadly Music, traditional dance and a kids corner.

The three-course bush food inspired dinner will include a special children's menu and the menu, catered by award-winning Pauletts Bush DeVine Winery Restaurant, will be guided by Ngadjuri Elder, Angelena Harradine.

The Clare Valley traditionally celebrates NAIDOC at this time of the year to ensure that our regional communities can attend.

The 2023 NAIDOC theme, For Our Elders, celebrates the part Elders have played, and continue to play, across every generation in their important role and prominent place in communities and families.

Elders are the cultural knowledge-holders, trailblazers, nurturers, advocates, teachers, survivors, leaders, hard workers and loved ones who guide generations. The Clare Valley event will play a part in paying respects to the Elders and their influence, tenacity and strength.
