MARCH COUNCIL MEETING UPDATE

Bizen Yoshinaga Delegation

10 students and 3 adults from Bizen City, Japan, will visit our district in August as part of our Sister City Relationship which began in 1990. Councillors agreed to consider a budget allocation in 2023/24 of \$10,000 to assist with expenses.

Riverton Community Hall

Council continues to work with architects and the community to look at options for the refurbishment and repairs of the Riverton Hall and is currently seeking cost estimates for different scenarios.

Community Survey

A recent community survey has provided Council with some excellent data which will help inform future decision making. You can see the comprehensive survey report within the March 2023 Ordinary Meeting of Council agenda document.

Riverton IGA Trolley Stand

Council approved the lease of a portion of the footpath outside the Riverton IGA supermarket on Torrens Road for use as a trolley stand for a lease period of 20 years.

Square Mile Road Speed Limit

Councillors have supported a change to the speed limit along Square Mile Road, Stanley Flat, to 50km. This will be an extension of the current 50km/h speed zone which currently ends 30 meters past Norman Drive.

Revocation of Community Land – Auburn RSL

This report has been approved for public consultation. Council resolved, in January 2023, to grant \$20,000 of the proceeds of the sale of the building to the Clare & Districts RSL sub-branch with remaining funds utilised to help deliver community projects in Auburn.

Mid North Community Passenger Network

Nine new volunteers have joined the team and initial discussions have been held about a proposed second bus route for the Regional Council of Goyder.

Libraries

The libraries have been busy with 4,090 people visiting in February and 43 new registrations. There were a total of 13,375 library loans in that month.

Development

32 development applications were received in February and there were 28 projects approved in that month, value at nearly \$3 million. A total of 196 approvals valued at \$22.7m so far, this financial year.

Photography Competition

The 2023 competition is about to be released seeking photos from the public. The winning photographs will be used to create a calendar which will promote our region.

Regional Planning

The State Government has begun stakeholder engagement to deliver the Regional Plan for the Yorke Peninsula and Mid North.

The Riverton Waste Transfer Station, 15 Bruce Road, Riverton, is open fortnightly on Sundays from 10am – 2pm and is free for residents and ratepayers with a Council Waste Transfer Card (domestic volumes only). Replacement cards are available from Council. It will be open again this Sunday, April 2, 2023.
