Community Asset Grants Scheme

The 2023-24 round of the Community Asset Grants Scheme is now open. The Scheme provides community groups within the Clare & Gilbert Valleys Council region with financial assistance to help support the Council in meeting its strategic objectives and empowers communities to progress and improve their local area through planned assistance and equitable distribution of allocated Council funding. The scheme is competitive – Council staff are available to discuss your project ideas and provide any clarification. Guidelines and application forms are on our website. Applications close 5pm Thursday 21 September 2023.

Stanley Flat – Code Amendment

A 'Code Amendment' to consider rezoning three parcels of land at Allotments 1,2 and 3, White Hut Road, Stanley Flat, is open for community consultation. The Code Amendment proposes to replace the current Rural Zone with the Rural Neighbourhood Zone which supports building new homes on larger allotments in rural settings. Up to 63 additional allotments could be created over the site to help meet market demand for larger blocks of land in the Stanley Flat area. The proponent for this Code Amendment is Nicholls Sunset Pty Ltd, the owners of the land. To have your say go to Council's website – consultation ends 5pm, 19 September, 2023.
