CHANGES TO EXPECT

New FOGO (Food Organics & Green Organics) 240 litre bin collection

All bins will be collected fortnightly (every two weeks) from February 2023.

KERBSIDE BIN PLACEMENT

Bins should be placed at the kerbside by 6am on the collection day. Keep a minimum distance of 1 metre between bins, parked cars, street trees and infrastructure. Bins must be brought in on the day they are emptied.

Your bin will not be collected if it is:

- packed too tightly and will not empty
- too heavy
- over-full.

FOOD SCRAPS GO IN THE GREEN BIN

All food scraps including fruit and vegetables, coffee grounds, dairy products, egg and oyster shells, bones, meat and seafood, as well as paper, shredded paper, paper towels and tissues must now be placed in the FOGO (Food Organics Green Organics) bin.

Cardboard can also be placed into the organics bin.

KITCHEN CADDY

You will be provided with a quantity of **compostable** kitchen caddy liners. It will be your responsibility to source replacement compostable liners or line your caddy with newspaper when your supply runs out.

STEP 2

Check the calendar below to determine which bin is collected on your collection day. Good Friday 7 April recycle will be collected Thursday 6 April.
