- ✓ Technical expertise (exposure; depth of field; colour or tonal rendition; contrast; and lighting).
- ✓ General characteristics (originality; style; context; photographic vision).
- ✓ Overall impact (Whether the photo was able to grab and hold the viewers' attention. Is there a "wow" factor).
