MAY COUNCIL MEETING UPDATE

Major projects

The sealed roads program is complete and this financial year's re-sheeting program is on schedule with Campbell Road and Possingham Pit Road complete. The Cornwell Road Bridge project is 50% complete. The playground renewal program currently sits at 82% complete, with a new slide ordered for the Tarlee playground.

Auburn Library

The Auburn Community Development Committee will be gifted the Auburn Community Library following land revocation – the commencement of the process has been agreed to by Council.

Watervale Code Amendment

Council has supported a proposal to initiate the Watervale Code Amendment which could see 11 allotments created in Watervale for future housing development.

Housing report

A report on the chronic shortage of housing in the district was discussed at the last Council meeting and can be accessed on the website.

Mid North Community Passenger Network

The Network has been busy with bookings filling quickly and trips needing to be booked a few months in advance. The Riverton car will be changed to a new Toyota Rav4 Hybrid. The network has 11 new volunteer drivers going through the accreditation process. The current number of accredited drivers is 56.

Planning & Development

25 new development approvals were received in April - so far 217 approvals have gone through, with an accumulated value of \$24.6 million so far for this financial year.
