# Waste Transfer Station Cards

New cards for this financial year will be issued in your upcoming rates notices, but residents and ratepayers can still use their 2021/22 Waste Transfer Station cards until new ones arrive. If you do not receive a card and you are a Clare & Gilbert Valleys resident, cards can be picked up from Council's office, or call 8842 6400. Card holders are entitled to free access to the Council's Waste Transfer Station at Clare and the Satellite Waste Transfer Station at Riverton for the disposal of residential waste/recyclables (boot/6x4 trailer/utility/van only). Conditions apply.

The Riverton Waste Transfer Station, 15 Bruce Road, Riverton, is open fortnightly on Sundays from 10am – 2pm and is free for residents and ratepayers with a Council Waste Transfer Card (domestic volumes only). Replacement cards are available from Council. It will be open again this Sunday, July 10.

### Please do not add coals to waste

Adding coals from wood fires or barbecues into your waste can ignite a fire. Please do not put coals of any kind into the green waste at the Clare Waste Transfer Station.

### Please segregate your waste

When bringing waste into the Clare Waste Transfer Station at Bennys Hill it should be segregated into categories – Segregating waste helps reduce costs to Council (ratepayers). Categories are as follows: scrap metal; electrical appliances; timber; mattresses; e-waste; green waste; empty fire extinguishers; clean drums; household/kitchen waste; car/truck batteries; plastic waste oil containers; small quantity clean concrete and tiles; glass; paper/cardboard; empty gas cylinders; household recyclables. What is not accepted – ammunition/explosives/flares; asbestos; chemicals; cooking oil; paint tins; hazardous waste; liquid waste; dead animals; soils/ commercial loads of construction and demolition material; tyres.

## **Council Elections**

Council elections will be held in November 2022 and are held by postal vote. The voters' roll closes on July 29, 2022 and nominations open on 23 August 2022 – closing 6 September 2022.
