Be ready for the Conversation

Later this year Australia will have a referendum. It's about whether we should change the Constitution to recognise the First Peoples of Australia by establishing a body called the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Voice. The Voice would be an independent and permanent advisory body for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
