Due to challenges and difficulties surrounding Australia Day celebrations, Council, early in its term, considered how these difficulties might be addressed. Council resolved that the celebrations remain the same until consultation can be undertaken with the wider community, including the relevant peak bodies of Riverton, Saddleworth and Auburn.

Community members are invited to have their say about how Australia Day should be celebrated in the future and whether it should continue with the current format of three Council events being held across the district, or if a single, large event would be preferable.
