1. Policy Objectives

That Clare & Gilbert Valleys Council provide five categories of awards for Australia Day:

- Australia Day Citizen of the Year Award
- Australia Day Young Citizen of the Year Award
- Community Event of the Year Award
- Active Citizen of the Year
- Volunteer of the Year

That the Volunteer of the year Award be to acknowledge and celebrate the contribution that volunteers make to the district, and that person is entered into the state award for Volunteers

That Council promote and advertise the Awards and call for nominations for the Awards in September with the close of nominations to be in conformance with date advised by the Australia Day Council.

That the Awards Committee comprise of:

- The Mayor
- CEO
- Two Councillors
- One past Australia Day Award recipient

That the selection committees be instructed to select a minimum of one (1) worthy recipient for each category for which nominations have been received.

With final selection to be ratified by the full Council at its November / December meeting.
