

## Development Application Checklist

### Baseline documentation for development applications requiring building rules consent

When development applications are lodged under the *Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016*, baseline documentation may need to be provided with the application. Baseline documentation is required for any application that requires a Building Rules Consent. The documentation required depends on the type of development that is proposed and is outlined in Schedule 8 (Plans) of the Planning, Development and Infrastructure Regulations 2017. If an application is lodged without its required baseline documentation, the relevant authority may request additional information before proceeding further. Alternatively, a Relevant Authority may choose to waive the documentation requirement if it is deemed appropriate to do so.

*\*Relevant Authority - the decision-maker who assesses the development application. This could be an Assessment Manager from council, an independent accredited professional, State Planning Commission or relevant panel.*
