Recycling chemical drums all year round

Up until now agricultural and veterinary chemical users have only been able to recycle their empty containers during designated drum muster days.

The Clare & Gilbert Valleys Council has installed a drum compound at the Clare Transfer Station which can be used to recycle empty chemical drums every Thursday and Friday from 8am to 5pm (closed for lunch 12.30-1pm).

This service is in addition to the annual drumMUSTER collection each July at the Saddleworth Council Depot, which is scheduled for Monday 22 and Tuesday 23 July, 2019.

Up to 20 drums can be dropped off at a time at the Clare Transfer Station, while larger amounts will need to be advised in advance, so an additional staff member can be on site to assist. Call Council on 8842 6400 if more than 20 drums are planned to be brought in for recycling.

Drums cannot be dropped off at the Transfer Station on Sundays.
