### Signage concerns

A proliferation of road signage around the district is causing concern in the Clare & Gilbert Valleys Council district as it becomes a distraction for motorists.

Council's Manager, Development and Community, Andrew Christiansen said council would be contacting business owners who have placed signs without development approval to discuss options with them.

"Signage requires development approval because it can cause driver distraction if incorrectly placed and can also look unsightly. In many situations, particularly along State Government roads, it is not allowed" Mr Christiansen said.

"We are happy to discuss applications for appropriate signage with business owners as often a good compromise can be found."
